JACKIE ROBINSON FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** February 15
- **Eligibility:** Be a graduating high school senior; plan to attend an accredited and approved four-year institution within the United States; show leadership potential; demonstrate a dedication to community service; present evidence of financial need; be a United States citizen; have a minimum SAT score of 1,000 combined on the math and critical reading sections or a composite ACT score of 21; not possess a degree from a 2 or 4-year College when applying for the scholarship.

DALLAS SCOTTISH RITE LIBRARY & MUSEUM SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** February 23
- **Eligibility:** You must be a high school senior
- Application available in the counseling center

AUSTIN BANK SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** February 26
- Application available in the counseling center **AND** in a computer format – see Ms. Giles or Mrs. Johnson
- **Eligibility:** You must be a high school senior with a 2.5 GPA or greater
- There will be scholarships awarded in both \$2,500 and \$500 amounts to students throughout East Texas.

DALLAS SCOTTISH RITE LIBRARY & MUSEUM SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** February 26
- Application available in the counseling center **AND** in a computer format – see Ms. Giles or Mrs. Johnson
- **Eligibility:** You must be a high school senior with a 2.5 GPA or greater
- There will be scholarships awarded in both \$2,500 and \$500 amounts to students throughout East Texas.

EAST TEXAS COMMUNITIES SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Deadline:** March 1 at 5:00 pm
- **Eligibility:** **Multiple scholarships available**; student must check to see what scholarships they are eligible for on the website; there IS a scholarship listed that is ONLY available to PHS students

EAST TEXAS PROFESSIONAL CREDIT UNION – MCLAUHLIN SCHOLARSHIP – EDUCATION MAJORS

- **Deadline:** March 1
- **Amount of award:** \$2000
- Must work toward a degree in the field of education
- **Eligibility:** High school senior; pursuing a degree in education; student or immediate family member must have an account in good standing with ETPCU
- Application available in the counseling center

EAST TEXAS PROFESSIONAL CREDIT UNION – PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 1
- **Amount of award:** \$1000
- **Eligibility:** High school senior; student or immediate family member must have an account in good standing with ETPCU
- Application available in the counseling center

TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONDITIONAL GRANT PROGRAM

- **Deadline:** March 1
- Application available in the counseling center
- **Eligibility:** Must pursue a degree in civil engineering or a department approved operational business discipline; be a Texas resident eligible to work in the U.S.; have a minimum high school grade point average of 3.00 on a four-point scale, or a minimum score of 900 on the SAT or a minimum score of 21 on the ACT, plan to attend an accredited four-year Texas public or private college or university as a full-time student (minimum 12 semester hours), declare an intent to seek a four-year degree in civil engineering or a department approved operational business discipline, agree to work for TxDOT for two years immediately following graduation

PALESTINE HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 9 by 3:25 pm
- **Eligibility:** character, school involvement, community service and financial need are all considered
- Application available in the counseling center

WILLIAM BONNER INGRAM SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 9
- **Eligibility:** High school senior; in need of financial assistance; worked hard to achieve goals; involved in extra-curricular activities; involved in the community
- Application available in the counseling center

ANDERSON COUNTY FARM BUREAU

- **Deadline:** March 15
- **Amount of award:** \$1000
- **Eligibility:** Must be an active member of FFA and/or 4H; be a high school senior; be a member of a Farm Bureau family in good standing for 1 year; demonstrated community service in the area of agriculture

- Application available in the counseling center

TTA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline: March 23**
- Eligibility: must be a US citizen graduating from a Texas high school, enrolling in a Texas college or university in Fall 2018; must have a 3.0 GPA or higher; must provide a letter of acceptance to your college or university; must provide a copy of your SAR (student aid report) from FAFSA
- Application available in the counseling center
- COMPLETED APPLICATION MUST BE RETURNED TO THE COUNSELING CENTER

ANDERSON COUNTY YOUTH LIVESTOCK ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline: March 23**
- Eligibility: Must reside in and attend school in Anderson County; must participate in interview; must have participated in FFA or 4-H two years of the four years of high school
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE NEGRO BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S CLUB, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline: March 31**
- Eligibility: Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE COMMUNITY THEATER, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline: March 31**
- Eligibility: current high school senior in an Anderson County high school, resident of Anderson County, enrolling in college in Fall 2018
- A major in Fine or Performing Arts is **NOT required**, though students pursuing those degrees **may** have greater odds as may those who have performed community service particularly for Arts organizations. Our goal is to encourage volunteerism while supporting the future of the Arts in East Texas.

- **Deadline: April 1**
- Amount of award: 3 in the amount of \$750
- Eligibility: Must be a high school senior
- Application available in the counseling center

LILLY ENTERPRISES – MCDONALD'S SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline: April 5**
- **All students are encouraged to apply** – you must complete the application, submit a resume and complete the essays
- Application available in the counseling center

CONGO TRUCK CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** April 6
- **Eligibility:** Must be a graduate of an Anderson County high school; must be planning to attend a college or trade school
- Application available in the counseling center

TRINITY VALLEY ELECTRIC COOP SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** April 13
- **Eligibility:** Must have a parent or legal guardian receiving TVEC electric service at their primary residence; must be a graduating senior; must rank in the top 20 % of the class; must be enrolling full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning
- Application available in the counseling center
- COMPLETED APPLICATION MUST BE RETURNED TO THE COUNSELING CENTER

WALTER V. HANKLA SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** April 13
- **Eligibility:** Must be a graduating senior; must be enrolling full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning; must exhibit excellence in Christian citizenship and mathematics
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** April 14
- **Eligibility:** High school senior; must pursue a degree in health care; must submit evidence of participation in extra-curricular activities; must reside in the hospital service area
- Application available in the counseling center

JUBELA-PRESLEY SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** April 20
- **Eligibility:** Must be a graduate of a local high school; must be planning to attend college or trade school in the fall
- Application available in the counseling center

PRIDE OF PALESTINE ORDER OF EASTERN STAR CH #012 SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** April 27
- **Eligibility:** Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher; must be attending a college or technical school in the Fall of 2018; must have 2 letters of recommendation
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** May 1 at 5 pm
- **Eligibility:** Must be a senior graduating from a high school in Anderson County; must be attending an accredited college, university or trade school
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** May 1 at 4 pm
- **Eligibility:** Must be a senior graduating from a high school in Anderson County and must be an Anderson County resident
- Application available in the counseling center

- **Deadline:** May 1
- **Eligibility:** Must be a senior; must show financial need; must have at least a 3.0 GPA
