HOUSTON COUNTY ELECTRIC COOP - DOROTHY GOODRUM SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** January 15
- **Eligibility:** High school senior whose parents maintain a PERMANENT RESIDENCE using Houston County Electric Coop; planning to attend an accredited college, university, trade school or business school; applicant must be of good character
- **Application:** available in the counseling center

CARR P. COLLINS SCHOLARS PROGRAM - BAYLOR UNIVERSITY

- **Deadline:** January 31
- Amount of award: 11 awards - \$5350, renewable for 3 additional years
- Application available online at baylor.edu/admissions/CarrPCollins
- Be unconditionally admitted to the University; be in the top quarter of their graduating class; have a minimum score of 1310 on the SAT or 28 on the ACT; have completed a balanced college preparatory program including history, science and a foreign language; be a resident of the state of Texas; rank in the top quarter of the graduating class
- Must submit application, resume, essay and nomination

ARMY STAFF SGT. SPECIAL AGENT RICHARD S. EATON, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** January 31
- Amount of award: \$1,000
- **Eligibility:** Students pursuing scholastic study in fields related to Alliance Building, Counterintelligence, Cultural Understanding, and National Security Studies

TEXAS STUDENT HOUSING SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** January 31
- **Eligibility:** Must be a Texas high school graduating senior accepted to a college in Austin, College Station or Denton; must live off-campus; must submit SAT or ACT score; must maintain a 3.0 GPA for renewal
- **Application:** available in the counseling center

- **Scholarships open November 15**
- **Deadline:** February 1
- More than 1,000 scholarships available - only one application to complete!
- Some scholarships are available to NON-FFA members

EAST TEXAS COMMUNITIES SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Deadline:** March 1 at 5:00 pm
- **Eligibility:** **Multiple scholarships available**; student must check to see what scholarships they are eligible for on the website; there IS a scholarship listed that is ONLY available to PHS students
- **Application :** www.etcf.org

AUSTIN BANK SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 1
- Application available in the counseling center **AND** in a computer format – see Ms. Giles or Mrs. Johnson
- **Eligibility:** You must be a high school senior with a 2.5 GPA or greater
- Application available in the counseling center

EAST TEXAS PROFESSIONAL CREDIT UNION – MCLAUHLIN SCHOLARSHIP – EDUCATION MAJORS

- **Deadline:** March 1
- **Amount of award:** \$2000
- Must work toward a degree in the field of education
- **Eligibility:** High school senior; pursuing a degree in education; student or immediate family member must have an account in good standing with ETPCU
- Application available in the counseling center

EAST TEXAS PROFESSIONAL CREDIT UNION – PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 1
- **Amount of award:** \$1000
- **Eligibility:** High school senior; student or immediate family member must have an account in good standing with ETPCU
- Application available in the counseling center

CONGO TRUCK CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 22
- **Eligibility:** Must be a graduate of an Anderson County high school; must be planning to attend a college or trade school
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE NEGRO BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S CLUB, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 22
- **Eligibility:** Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Application available in the counseling center

PALESTINE COMMUNITY THEATER, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

- **Deadline:** March 31
- **Eligibility:** current high school senior in an Anderson County high school, resident of Anderson County, enrolling in college in Fall 2019
- A major in Fine or Performing Arts is **NOT required**, though students pursuing those degrees **may** have greater odds as may those who have performed community service particularly for Arts organizations. Our goal is to encourage volunteerism while supporting the future of the Arts in East Texas.
