For she is Beauty tamer of the Beast.

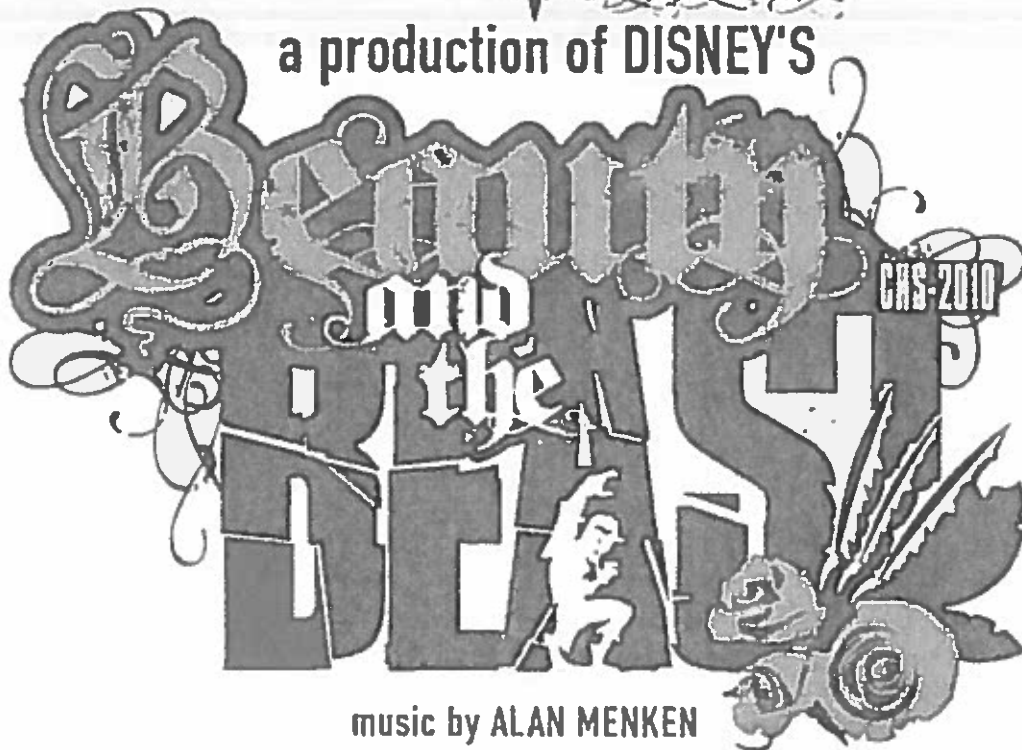
