Palestine ISD Schools

Student Technology Agreement & Regulations - Mobile Devices

The Student Technology Agreement & Regulations is between the student and Palestine ISD, and is subject to the terms and conditions below. The term “mobile device” includes all components: the physical device, applications, power cords, case & peripherals. The student is a licensee with right to use the technology equipment during the term of this agreement subject to all other terms and conditions stated herein. The student is responsible for the security, care, custody, and control of the technology equipment at all times. The student shall not allow unknown or unauthorized individuals to use or access the Technology equipment. The student is responsible for the actions of others while in possession of the technology equipment. The student will not allow any other person to access his/ her network student account or password. The student has no expectation of privacy with respect to his/her use of the technology equipment. Personal use of the technology equipment is authorized provided that such use does not interfere with performance of the student’s schoolwork and does not otherwise violate any other provision of this agreement. The student shall be responsible for maintaining any confidential information of the technology equipment.

_____ I understand and agree it is my responsibility to provide a safe and secure environment for the technology equipment assigned to me. I understand that I will be charged the replacement cost of the technology cost if found negligent in this responsibility.

_____ I understand that lost or stolen equipment must be reported to the principal and technology staff within 48 hours or I am held responsible for the replacement cost of the technology equipment.

_____ I understand that lost or stolen equipment must be reported to the law enforcement and it is my responsibility to file a police report and give a copy to Palestine ISD.

_____ I understand in the case of lost or stolen technology equipment, the District reserves the right NOT to issue a replacement.

_____ I understand that I am expected to abide by the district’s Student Responsible Use Guidelines, which extends to both home use and school use of the technology equipment.

_____ I understand that failure to follow the guidelines and regulations listed in the aforementioned document, or the Student Responsible Use Guidelines, and/or use of technology equipment to violate school, district, state, or federal laws may result in disciplinary action.

_____ I understand that I may maintain possession of the technology equipment so long as I am a student with Palestine ISD. I agree to return the technology equipment upon transferring to another school, or upon the district request. I authorize the District to charge for the total replacement cost of the technology equipment that has not been returned. I further understand that the District may choose to pursue legal action if I do not return the technology equipment.

Palestine Independent School District Responsible Use Guidelines for Technology

Our staff and students use technology to learn. Technology is essential to facilitate the creative problem-solving, information fluency, communication and collaboration that we see today. While we want our students to be active in our connected world, we also want them to be safe, legal and responsible. The Responsible Use Guidelines (RUG) support our vision of responsible technology use and promote a strong sense of digital citizenship. The RUG applies to all Palestine ISD computer networks and the devices made available by them and all devices connected to those networks (whether they be student owned or otherwise).

- _____ I understand that the use of school technology is for educational purposes and will not use any resource (games, social media sites, messaging, etc.) in a manner that disturbs the learning process.
- _____ I will always use appropriate and respectful language in my academic work, when posting comments online and in social communities, and in e-mails or other means of electronic communication.
- _____ I understand that anything I do online or electronically is not private and may be monitored.
- _____ I will keep personal information about myself and others private at all times.
- _____ I will only use my username and password to log-in to a school device, website or learning management system. I will not share my username and password with anyone except a teacher, administrator or my parent/guardian.
- _____ I will seek help if I feel unsafe, bullied or witness unkind behavior. I understand that certain behaviors such as cyberbullying and “sexting” (the digital transmission or inappropriate messages, photos or videos) may result in legal consequences or convictions in a court of law.
- _____ I will respect the intellectual property of others and properly acknowledge all information, videos, photos or music acquired through online sources. I will never take credit for another person’s work.
- _____ I will not use technology to cheat or share information with other students about a test or a non-collaborative project or assignment.
- _____ I will maintain a positive “digital footprint” and understand that anything I post online about myself or others may affect my reputation and future job or college prospects.
- _____ I will take care of all technology both on and off campus and report misuse or inappropriate use to my teachers or an administrator.
- _____ I understand that use of any means to encrypt communications or files, disable or bypass the district’s Internet filtering or security system is subject to PISD’s Student Behavior Policy.
- _____ I will not attempt to destroy, disable or gain access to district computer equipment, district data, the data of other users, or other networks connected to the district’s system, including uploading or creating computer viruses.

I have read the District’s RUG and agree to abide by its provisions. It is understood that access to the internet, the District’s computer network system, or District technology is a privilege, not a right. Failure to abide by the guidelines in this document could result in the revocation or access privileges, disciplinary action, or legal action, as deemed appropriate. In addition, I understand that there are certain expectations and responsibilities regarding what I do online. I understand that the school district will provide me with third party accounts (such as Google Apps) that must also adhere to these Responsible Use Guidelines. Any other third party accounts that I use for educational purposes, must also adhere to these Responsible Use Guidelines. I agree to the above rules.

In consideration for the privilege of using of Palestine ISD’s Internet, Computer Network System, and Technology, I hereby release Palestine ISD, its operators, and any institutions with which they are affiliated from any and all claims and damages of any nature arising from my use of, or inability to use, the system, including, without limitation, the type of damage identified in the Palestine ISD’s RUG.
